BRINGING THE HOLIDAY SPIRIT TO OUR VILLAGE!

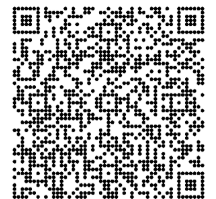
**BLISSFIELD RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, AND GROUPS

Thirty fresh-cut trees will be staked at Ellis park. Each tree includes a keepsake sign with the name of the sponsor.

- Trees assignments will be marked by November 27, 2023.
- Light and decorate your assigned tree starting November 27.
- Every tree has a power outlet. A timer will automatically turn lights on and off.
- Decorations should be waterproof and weatherproof.
- The wind is strong along the river, ornaments should be wired or zip tied to your tree.
- No edible decorations allowed as that could attract animals.
- All decorating should be finished by December 2.
- **NEW:** A First Light Party will be held on Saturday, December 2 with hot cocoa and cookies.
 Inclement weather delay date: Sunday, December 3.
- Decorations can be removed starting January 1, 2024.
- Any decorations left after January 7 will be disposed of.

REMINDER: These trees will be showcased in a public park, please decorate accordingly. The Blissfield Parks and Recreation Advisory Board reserves the right to remove any decorations that are deemed advertisements, political, or offensive.
