**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 24 POOL ROOMS AND BOWLING ALLEYS OF THE VILLAGE CODE**  
**FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLISSFIELD.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has established council goals and objectives with one of them being to update ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, the following ordinance is outdated and irrelevant; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the governing body of the Village of Blissfield, Michigan that Chapter 24 be repealed following passage and publication to repeal hereinafter specified:

~~24.000 – POOL ROOMS AND BOWLING ALLEYS~~

~~24.001 – Definitions.~~

~~Sec. 1. The term pool room as used in this Chapter shall mean any place open to the public for playing pool or billiards. The term bowling alley shall mean any place open to the public for bowling.~~

~~24.002 – License required.~~

~~Sec. 2. No person shall engage in the business of operating a pool room or bowling alley without first obtaining a license therefor. No license shall be granted except upon certification of the Chief of Police and unless a complete set of fingerprints of the applicant therefor are on file in the noncriminal identification file of the Police Department. Each license shall designate the number of pool or billiard tables or bowling alleys permitted thereunder, and no licensee shall keep or maintain more tables or alleys than permitted by such license.~~
