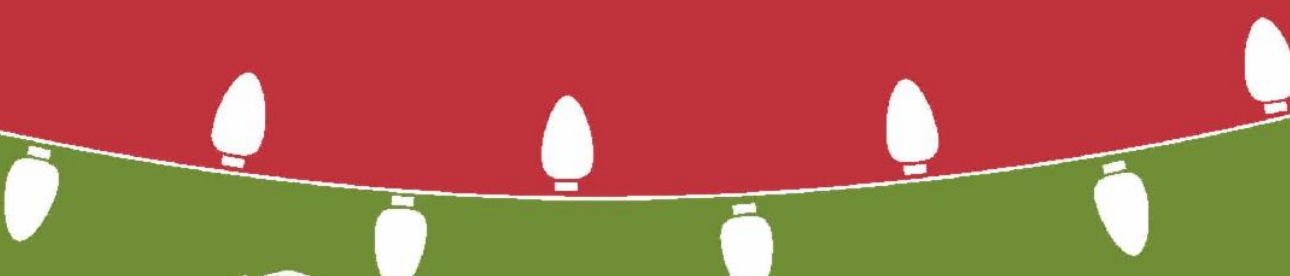

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

DAY	AREA
Mondays and Tuesdays	South of US223 and East of River Raisin
Wednesdays	North of US223 and East of River Raisin
Thursdays	North of US223 and West of River Raisin
Fridays	South of US223 and West of River Raisin

Rake your leaves to the curb for the DPW crew to pick up. Do not rake your leaves into the street and do not burn your leaves. Keep the piles away from utility poles, signs, trees and guy wires. Do not mix brush and garden materials with the leaves.

Being that the month of November is solely devoted to collection of leaves, there will be no brush pickup. From December through February, brush pickup will occur on the 2nd Tuesdays only.
